### Coordinating Universities for the Proposal: UCM and UPM

<p><b>Objectives:</b></p> <p>To transform the UCM's Colegio Mayor Antonio de Nebrija into a university residence facilitating a more self-sufficient life style for residents.</p>			
<p><b>Description of the action:</b></p> <p>The Colegio Mayor Antonio de Nebrija, belonging to the Complutense University, requires important reform and rehabilitation work, especially the Colegio Antonio de Nebrija building which has already been closed as it needs urgent repair work.</p> <p>As this is the case, the opportunity will be taken to offer students a different format from that currently available in the existing residences on campus: self-catering study bedrooms which will allow the students more independence, with kitchen facilities, etc.</p> <p>The location of this on-campus residence, in a quiet, leafy setting between the Parque del Oeste and the sports complex to the south of the campus, but at the same time just a few minutes from Moncloa, makes this a very suitable site for this type of residence.</p> <p>A partner will be sought to carry out the project and subsequent running of the complex through an appropriate agreement to guarantee the viability and maintenance of the centre in line with the required quality standards , or it may be managed through a joint action with the MVIV (Ministry for Housing).</p> <p>The proposed residence will also be used to facilitate and encourage recruitment of international students and researchers, in collaboration with talent recruitment programs, and for visiting professors for periods longer than a week, for whom off-campus hotel accommodation is expensive and unsuitable.</p> <p>In this context, the initiative developed by the UCM to reserve 20 study bedrooms in the Galdós University Residence on the Campus, making them available to the university community, has been very satisfactory, and is an added incentive for the action proposed here.</p>
